

Sermon Questions Week of February 26 2023

Psalm 33

1. Who are the righteous or the upright in Vs 1 of Psalm 33? How does this compare to the righteous today?
2. What does it mean to praise the LORD? How is this different from worship? How should we praise God, and worship God?
3. He loves righteousness and justice, the earth is full of the steadfast love of the LORD. Romans 3:19-26 further shows how God who loves righteousness acts in righteousness. Discuss in your group how and why this is important.
4. Verse 18 reads the eye of the LORD is on those who fear him. This implies He safeguards those who love Him. Does this mean we will never suffer or need anything? What does this statement mean to us today?
5. What are some things you fear? How is this fear different than the fear of the LORD? How does fear of the LORD draw us closer to Him?
6. Psalm 33: vs 16-17 mention a great army, great strength, and great might, all of which cannot rescue. How does this affect our trust in God?
7. The love of the LORD is steadfast, his word stands firm, the counsel of the LORD stands forever. The unconditional statement of trust in Vs 21 reads "For our heart is glad in him, because we trust in his holy name". Can we and do we trust God in this way? How should we live in light of this trust?
